Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor (CADC) Training



CADC training provides...

an introductory learning experience in substance abuse counseling, promoting professional development and growth.

The 48-credit, 16-week course is designed to prepare students to take the written exam required for CADC certification. It also provides a comprehensive foundation in all domains of addiction treatment as well as the opportunity for students to meet and network with other professionals.

The Delaware Certification Board approves the program as a training center.

Fees and Payments

Classes are \$40 per session

Pay in Advance Plan

Take all 48 hours and pay \$550 in advance—a 15% discount over classes paid for individually.

Pay as You Go Plan

Participants pick and choose specific sessions to attend. Each class must be paid for at beginning of the class attended. Total cost — \$640

MASTER CARD & VISA are accepted.

Students may not attend two consecutive classes without payment. Attendance certificates are awarded for each class.

Students receive attendance certificates only if payment is made for the session.

Program Features

Each 16-week session presents instruction on topics designed to assist counselors in pre-treatment, treatment, and aftercare to improve outcomes and foster long-term, quality recovery for clients.
