Resource Submission Form**

Title: Saint Taboo **Grade Level(s):** *Middle through High School*

Curriculum area(s): *Religion- Knowledge of Saints*

Objective: *To have fun while learning about the saints*

Materials Needed: *Taboo Cards (a document is attached. It may be printed on card stock, cut into cards and then used in the game)*

A minute timer (or a stopwatch)

Procedure:

Students are divided into two teams. Players are arranged in a circle, and every other person is on the opposing team.

Teams take turns giving clues for the saint on the card. Members of the team for the clue giver try to guess the name of the saint being described. They give clues for as many saints as possible in 1 minute.

The clue giver must avoid saying the “taboo” words on the card when giving clues. The opposing team member to the left of the clue-giver checks to be sure taboo words are not used.

The card will be put back in the stack if a taboo word is used.

All cards guessed correctly are reserved by the team and will be counted at the end. Cards not guessed and those that had violations are but back in the deck.

Once all the cards have been played, the team in possession of the most cards wins.
